SUBJECT: [REMINDER] MANDATORY SURVEY - Locality Use of Ballot on

Demand (BOD) Printers for the November 2024 Elections

WHY THIS IS NEEDED: The Department of Elections needs to determine which localities

will be using BOD printers during early voting for the November

2024 General and Special Elections.

HOW THIS AFFECTS YOU: All localities must complete the survey, even if you will not

be using BOD printers.

The survey will allow you to indicate whether the locality will use a BOD system or if the the locality will not use a BOD system. The attached versions of the same survey show the survey questions dependent on if the locality will use a BOD system vs. if the locality will not use a BOD system. ELECT is as much interested in the "No" responses as the "Yes" responses as both compile data for the General Assembly's consumption.
